A world in which all people have an equal opportunity to benefit from medical science.

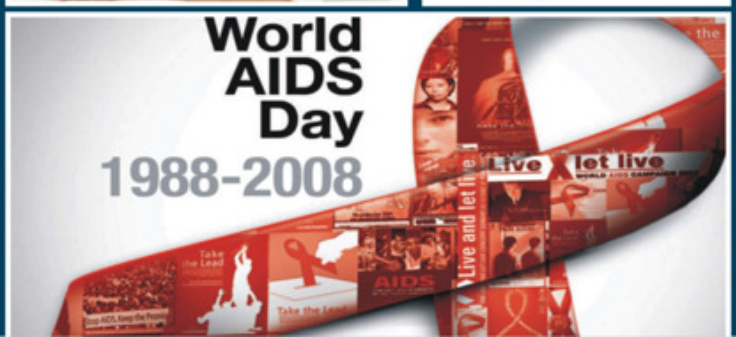
## MISSION:

Wants to Develop Ayurvedic health resorts to provide Ayurvedic treatment.

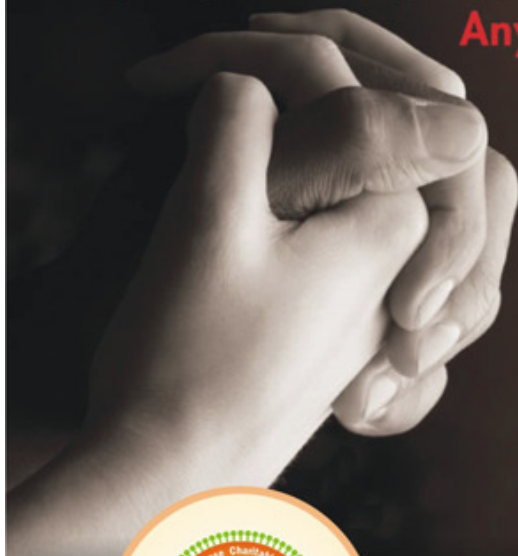

We have successfully implemented a project of cervical cancer awareness, screening and detection in 25 villages of Patan Taluka of Satara District. It has been funded by Sir Dorabji Tata Trust, Mumbai and almost 985 women have been benefited in one year from the same activities.
